Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Merit-cum means based scholarship to students belonging to minority communities to Government of Assam for the year 2007-08.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of non-recurring grant-in-aid of Rs. 13316841 (One crore thirty three lakh sixteen thousand eight hundred forty one only) as 100% Central share to the Govt. of Assam which comprises the fund of Rs. 12749841 (one crore twenty seven lakh forty nine thousand eight hundred forty one only) for disbursement of merit-cum means based scholarships to 504 (five hundred four) students and the fund of Rs. 5,67,000/- (Rupees five lakh sixty seven thousand only) for expenditure towards setting up of an I.T. enabled dedicated cell for implementation of the scheme of merit-cum means based scholarship, for the year 2007-08 as per details enclosed at Annexure. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of Assam through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.64 Ministry of Minority Affairs Major Head 3601 Grant-in-aid to State Government - 04 Grants for Central Plan Scheme (Sub Major Head) - 378 General-(Welfare of SCs/STs and OBCs)-other grants - 03- Merit-cum-means based scholarship for professional and technical courses - 03.00.31 Grant-in-aid for the year 2007-08.

3. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format (GFR 19-A) within 12 months of the date of the Sanction Order. It is to be certified by the grantee that no Utilization Certificate is pending in respect of previous grant/grants.

4. Guidelines for preparation of merit list for scholarships to students belonging to minority communities, contained in this Ministry's letter No.1(1)/2006-PP-I dated 13.12.2007 may be followed.
