Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Merit-cum means based scholarship to students belonging to minority communities to Govt. of Himachal Pradesh for the year 2007-08.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of non-recurring grant-in-aid of 257951 (Rupees Two lakh fifty seven thousand nine hundred fifty one only) as 100% Central share to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh for disbursement of merit-cum means based scholarships to 11 (eleven) students for implementation of the scheme of merit-cum means based scholarship, for the year 2007-08 as per details enclosed at Annexure. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

3. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format (GFR 19-A) within 12 months of the date of the Sanction Order. It is to be certified by the grantee that no Utilization Certificate is pending in respect of previous grant/grants.

4. Guidelines for preparation of merit list for scholarships to students belonging to minority communities, contained in this Ministry's letter No.1(1)/2006-PP-1 dated 13.12.2007 may be followed.

5. The State Government/UT. Administration should ensure that the sanctioned amount is disbursed to the institutes and students within one month from the date of crediting of fund in the state account.
