Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Merit-cum means based scholarship to students belonging to minority communities to Government of Manipur for the year 2007-08.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of non-recurring grant-in-aid of Rs. 3112352 (Rupees thirty one lakh twelve thousand three hundred fifty two only) as 100% Central share to the Govt. of ~~Manipur~~ <sup>Assam</sup> which comprises the fund of Rs. 2351952 (Rupees twenty three lakh fifty one thousand nine hundred fifty two only) for disbursement of merit-cum means based scholarships to 83 (eighty three) students and the fund of Rs. 760,400/- (Rupees seven lakh sixty thousand four hundred only) for expenditure towards setting up of an I.T. enabled dedicated cell for implementation of the scheme of merit-cum means based scholarship, for the year 2007-08 as per details enclosed at Annexure. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of Manipur through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

2. The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.64 Ministry of Minority Affairs Major Head 3601 Grant-in-aid to State Government - 04 Grants for Central Plan Scheme (Sub Major Head) - 378 General-(Welfare of SCs/STs and OBCs)-other grants - 03- Merit-cum-means based scholarship for professional and technical courses - 03.00.31 Grant-in-aid for the year 2007-08.

3. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format (GFR 19-A) within 12 months of the date of the Sanction Order. It is to be certified by the grantee that no Utilization Certificate is pending in respect of previous grant/grants.

4. Guidelines for preparation of merit list for scholarships to students belonging to minority communities, contained in this Ministry's letter No.1(1)/2006-PP-1 dated 13.12.2007 may be followed.

5. The State Government/UT. Administration should ensure that the sanctioned amount is disbursed to the institutes and students within one month from the date of crediting of fund in the state account.

6. This sanction issues with concurrence of J.S. & F.A. vide Dy. No.282/JS&FA dated 29.02.2008.


