Description and Definition of Success Indictors and Proposed Measurement Methodology

Values: -

- Release of funds by States/UT Governments is a pre-requisite for the success of the programmers
- Timely receipt of the proposals ensures timely release of funds
- Monitoring of the schemes through review meetings is essential for their effective implementation.

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Section 5

Specific Performance Requirements from other Departments

- States/UTs to submit proposals on time.
- Appraisal and comments of concerned line ministries to be obtained from projects related to their programmes/schemes.
- States/UTs to release fundsto line departments/beneficiaries on time.
- States/UTs to regularly monitor and report on the implementation of the programmers.
- Achievement of the target of 20000 fresh scholarships under Merit-cum-means scholarship is dependent on getting adequate proposals from State/UT Governments towards Buddhists and Christian quota meant for them, as inter-community diversion of unused quota is not permitted under the rules.
- Achievement and performance under RFD would be subject to the condition that atleast 80% of the sanctioned strength are filled.
