# MINUTES OF THE 55<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF EMPOWERED COMMITTEE UNDER MULTI-SECTORAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME HELD ON 23<sup>rd</sup> MARCH, 2012 UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF SECRETARY, MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

The 55<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Empowered Committee for MsDP to consider and approve the revised district plans in minority concentration districts of Kamrup, Goalpara, Karimganj, N.C Hills, Nagaon, Morigaon, Bongaigaon, Barpeta, Cachar, Dhubri, (Assam), North Sikkim (Sikkim),Ranchi, Gumla, Simdega, Pakur, Khunti (Jharkahnad), Kishanganj, Sitamarhi, Purnea (Bihar), Bareilly, Siddharth Nagar, Kheri, Bahraich, J.P. Nagar, Meerut, Saharanpur (Uttar Pradesh), Hardwar (Uttrakhand), Popumpare, East Kameng (Arunachal Pradesh) was held. The representative of the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Ministry of Human Resource Development and Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation attended the meeting. The officials from State Government attended the meeting through video conferencing. A list of officials present in the meeting is annexed.

2. **Progress on website:** The progress of implementation of MsDP is reported on quarterly basis to the Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU) in PMO (Prime Minister's Office) and the status of implementation of various projects in terms of funds released by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and utilised by the State/UT; number of works sanctioned, completed and works in progress is regularly monitored. These details and photographs of works are placed in the Ministry's website for transparency. State Governments/UT Administrations are required to review the implementation on quarterly basis; ensure that Central funds are released to the districts within one month of sanction; State share (wherever applicable) released along with the Central funds; ensure that the executing agencies start the construction works at the earliest, and complete the construction works within the scheduled period. A computer software application called MIS-MsDP has been made operational in July, 2011 and the States/UT have been advised to ensure that data is entered by all concerned so that Quarterly Progress Report (QPR), utilization certificate and various progress reports is generated through the software.



3. <u>Adhering to guidelines and eliminating duplication:</u> States/UTs should ensure that the proposals sent have the approval of the State Level Committee of MsDP / mission director of CSS concerned in order to ensure that the proposal, in terms of specification, norms, standards etc., is in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme concerned and that duplication has been ruled out. The responsibility for eliminating duplication of work and avoiding double counting of a scheme under two funding sources vested with both the district authority and the State Government. Accounts under MsDP should be maintained separately and Central Ministry concerned informed of assets created in respect of CSS topped up under MsDP.

4. <u>Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) guidelines:</u> MsDP provides that there would be no change in guidelines of any existing Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) under implementation in such districts for which this programme would provide additional funds. In case schemes for individual benefits are taken up under the programme, there shall be no divergence from existing norms for selection of beneficiaries from the list of BPL families in the district, so that benefits from the additional funds flow to all BPL families and not selectively. However, the provision under Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) guidelines for making separate allocation for Scheduled Castes (SC) or Scheduled Tribes (ST) will not be followed under MsDP. The entire number of units sanctioned under MsDP would be given to BPL households, from minority communities as well as other communities, in order of the serial number in the approved wait list without making separate allocation for Scheduled Castes (SC) or Scheduled Tribes (ST).

5. <u>**Timely release of funds:**</u> The sanction letters of the Ministry stipulate that funds should be released to the district/implementing agency within a month's time, but the States/UT have been generally taking much time in releasing funds to the district/implementing agency. State shares, wherever applicable, are not released along with the Central funds by some States. Prompt release of funds was advised to ensure that works are started at the earliest.

6. <u>Utilisation Certificate:</u> For release of second instalment, utilization certificate (UC) is required. If the UC is furnished within a period of one year after release by the Ministry, 60% UC would be required for releasing the next instalment. However, if utilization is made

beyond the period of a year, 100% utilization would be necessary. The UCs would need to be accompanied by QPR showing physical progress, photographs as proof of the work in progress and the phasing of funds for the release sought.

7. <u>Sample testing and quality control:</u> Quality control was to be ensured through regular and frequent field visits and by testing samples of the construction work for which funds would be sanctioned by the Ministry on receipt of request from the State concerned. The findings and observations contained in the report of Internal Auditor Team of the Ministry of Minority Affairs to Muzzaffar Nagar and Bijnor districts in Uttar Pradesh has been sent to all the States/UTs with advise to carry out field visits, quality control tests and review all works under MsDP to ensure that the shortcomings pointed out in the report do not take place in their State/UT.

8. <u>Inclusion of Members of Parliament in State and district level committees:</u> Members of Parliament (MP) and Member of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) have been included in the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the committee for MsDP. MLAs are also to be nominated on the Committees by the State Government. It should be ensured that they are invited to attend the meetings of the district and State level committees.

9. **Display boards:** Para 19 of the scheme of MsDP provides for a 'display board' which should have– Name of the project/scheme printed followed by "Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP), Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India." For projects with longer construction period, in addition to above, the name of implementing agency, date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion and estimated cost of the project should be printed on the display boards. States/UT should ensure this and put up a permanent display on completion of each project.

# General conditions applicable to projects approved by the Empowered Committee

10. For approvals given by the Empowered Committee, including in-principle approvals, the Principal Secretary/Secretary of States/UTs and the District Collectors/representatives were advised to note that the following conditions would apply to all projects under MsDP.

State Government/UT administration concerned should ensure that the following have been complied with:-

Approval of the State department concerned/Mission Director for Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) concerned have covered the following -

- (a) **Need** for having the proposal sanctioned under MsDP.
- (b) Duplication has been eliminated.
- (c) Proposal is as <u>per norms, specifications, layout design, funding norms and</u> <u>cost norms of the CSS guidelines</u> concerned.
- (d) <u>Separate accounts for schemes under MsDP will be maintained</u> and details sent to the Central Ministry concerned for maintaining proper record of assets and avoiding double counting and duplication.
- (e) <u>Estimates have been prepared as per Schedule of Rates (SOR)</u> of the State Government and have been <u>approved by a competent engineering department</u> of the State Govt.
- (b) Staff is available for functioning unit or will be provided for new unit.
- (c) <u>Recurring expenditure</u> would be provided by the State Government.
- (d) <u>Land is available and/or will be made available by the State Government in</u> <u>villages/locations having the highest proportion (percentage) of minority</u> <u>population.</u>

11. **Review meetings of Oversight committee in State, and State and district level committees:** The scheme of MsDP envisages quarterly review meetings by the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the review committees for MsDP. The State level committee also acts as the Oversight Committee for MsDP. Quarterly review meetings for State level committee/State Oversight Committee and district level Committee should be held and copy of the meeting notice should be sent to the Ministry to enable a representative to attend State Level meetings as envisaged under MsDP. It should be ensured that Members of Parliament nominated in such Committees are invited to attend the meetings.

12. Review by Oversight Committee: - The implementation of projects approved earlier by the Empowered Committee (EC) for the districts of Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and Arunachal Pradesh were reviewed by the Oversight Committee. It was

found that the status of submission of UCs from all the States is to be improved. Particularly, Bihar Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh were requested to undertake special reviews of progress of implementation of MsDP. Further, Assam and Uttarakhand were requested to release the funds to the implementing agencies as early as possible to carry out the projects.

13. <u>Photographs:</u> Photographs of completed works and works in progress indicating type of asset, name of location/village and date should be placed in the MIS-MsDP web page and officials from the State and districts were impressed upon the need to have photographs, in digital format sent by email to Mr. U.K Sinha, Under Secretary in the Ministry – <u>ujjwal.sinha@nic.in</u> The photographs are required for release of second installment.

# (A) <u>District plans and the proposal contained therein considered by the Empowered</u> <u>Committee and their recommendations:-</u>

#### Item No.(A) Assam

The Government of Assam submitted fresh proposals of ACRs in Primary/high/Sr. Secondary/Sr. Madarsa schools, hostels, AWCs, ITI, Drinking water supply, lab and toilets in schools in respect of Kamrup, Goalpara, Karimganj, N.C Hills, Nagaon, Morigaon, Bongaigaon, Barpeta, Cachar, Dhubri, districts. The State Government also furnished the following information with the proposal.

(i) No duplication certificate has been obtained from Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), PHED and Director of labour and Employment for the concerned projects.

(ii) Estimates have been prepared as per the Government of Assam approved rates.

2. The Principal Secretary of Assam informed during the meeting that all the proposals are for the minority concentration areas and the locations of the projects have more than 25% of minority population. The estimates have been prepared on the basis of the model cost estimates for the project approved earlier.

## Item No.(B) Sikkim

The Government of Sikkim has submitted fresh proposals of ACRs in schools in respect of North Sikkim districts. The Government of Sikkim has intimated that the proposal has been framed as per the district deficits identified. The approval of the State level and district level committees for the project has been obtained. The Government of Sikkim has committed the following.

(i) All the norms applicable for SSA/RMSA have been adopted.

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(ii) There is no duplication of these projects from other like SSA/RMSA.

(iii) The estimates have been prepared by the Engineering Cell of Human Resource Development Department as per SOR 2006 of the States.

(i) North Sikkim: Projects for 4 rural water supply scheme (RWSS) amounting to Rs.334.94 lakh was approved in 41st Empowered Committee held on 08/12/2010. Later on Department of drinking water supply objected to the proposal. Therefore the Government of Sikkim has decided to drop the projects and have submitted a fresh proposal of Rs.149.96 lakh against the balance of Rs.366.40 lakh. The Tender would be called for only after the decision of Empowered Committee in such cases

(i) Haridwar: The 32<sup>nd</sup> Empowered Committee meeting considered and approved in-principle for Construction of three new ITI at different location in Haridwar district, Uttrakhand for a total cost of Rs. 703.10 lakh. Later on the Govt. of Uttarkhand has submitted the DPR for construction of one ITI at Laksar in place of three ITIs which were approved earlier. The DPR was forwarded to the ministry of Labour & Employment for their observation/comments. On the basis of the DPR, the Ministry of Labour and Employment has given their no objection with the following conditions:

1. The objections with respect to the class room space and number of the staff quarters made by this ministry have been rectified accordingly, and the cost for civil works has



been revised downwards to Rs. 356.38 lakh for civil works against Rs. 404.61 lakh proposed earlier.

2. The ITI is proposed to be established for 3 trades. Although, no building plan has been received yet, it is observed from the area requirement for the building that there are 2 workshops have been proposed for the trade Fitter and Plastic Processing Operator (PPO) which may not be accepted. It may be stated as per NCVT norms only 1 workshop is sufficient for 2 units of the respective trades. Therefore, the total space requirement for 2 units of these trades worked out at 428 sq. mt. against 568 sq. mt. proposed in the DPR i.e. space of 140 sq. mt. is excess than required as per norms. This may not be agreed to. Therefore, it is suggested that the cost for civil works may be restricted to Rs. 337.40 lakh after reducing the cost towards excess workshop space @ Rs. 15840/- sq. mt. i.e. 140 sq. mts. as per the PWD SOR.

In view of the above, the Ministry of labour and Employment has no objection for setting up of above ITI for 2 units each of the new trade Fitter, Machine Tool Maintenance (MTM) and Plastic Processing Operator (PPO) at a total cost of Rs. 388.68 lakh as per the details given below:
