MINUTES OF THE 140th MEETING OF EMPOWERED COMMITTEE UNDER MULTI-SECTORAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME HELD ON 23.02.2018 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY, MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.


The 140th Meeting of the Empowered Committee (EC) for Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP) was held on 23.02.2018, under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Minority Affairs to consider and approve the project proposals with regard to the Minority Concentration Blocks/Towns received from State Governments of Jharkhand, Haryana, Mizoram, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Karnataka and Maharashtra. The representatives of the Ministry of WCD, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Ministry of Ayush, Ministry of Skill Development, NAWADCO, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and JS&FA(MA) were present during the meeting. State and district officials of Maharashtra, Jharkhand, Mizoram, Arunachal Pradesh, Haryana and Karnataka attended the meeting through video-conferencing.

2. **Progress on website:** The progress of implementation of MsDP is reported on quarterly basis to the Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU) in PMO (Prime Minister's Office) and the status of implementation of various projects in terms of funds released by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and utilized by the State/UT; number of works sanctioned, completed and works in progress is regularly monitored. These details of works are placed in the Ministry's website for transparency. State Governments/UT Administrations are required to review the implementation on quarterly basis; ensure that Central funds are released to the districts within one month of sanction; State share (wherever applicable) released along with the Central funds; ensure that the executing agencies start the construction works at the earliest, and complete the construction works within the scheduled period.

3. **Adhering to guidelines and eliminating duplication:** States/UTs should ensure that the proposals sent have the approval of the State Level Committee of MsDP / Mission Director of CSS concerned in order to ensure that the proposal, in terms of specification, norms, standards etc., is in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme concerned and that duplication has been ruled out. The responsibility for eliminating duplication of work and avoiding double counting of a scheme under two funding sources vested with both the district authority and the State Government. Accounts under MsDP should be maintained separately and Central Ministry concerned informed of assets created in respect of CSS topped up under MsDP.

4. The States/UTs were advised by the Empowered Committee to ensure that the catchment area of the assets created under MsDP have substantial minority population. Further the States/UTs would also ensure that the ownership of the assets created would be with the Govt/Govt body.

5. **Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) guidelines:** MsDP provides that there would be no change in guidelines of any existing Centrally Sponsored Scheme



(CSS) under implementation in such districts for which this programme would provide additional funds. Whenever CSS are sanctioned under MsDP, it shall be ensured by the Ministry of MA as well as the State Govt. that the Ministry/department concerned in the Centre and State are informed so that the number of units taken up are accounted in their physical register and are also inspected by their officials wherever spot inspections are carried out in the States.

6 . **Timely release of funds:** The sanction letters of the Ministry stipulate that funds should be released to the district/implementing agency within a month's time, but the States/UT have been generally taking much time in releasing funds to the district/implementing agency. State shares, wherever applicable, are not released along with the Central funds by some States. Prompt release of funds was advised to ensure that works are started at the earliest.

7. **Utilization Certificate:** For release of second installment, utilization certificate (UC) is required. If the UC is furnished within a period of one year after release by the Ministry, 60% UC would be required for releasing the next installment. However, if utilization is made beyond the period of a year, 100% utilization would be necessary. The UCs would need to be accompanied by QPR showing physical progress as proof of the work in progress. The Utilization Certificates of the 2nd and subsequent installment should also be submitted by the States/UTs to the Ministry.

8 . **Sample testing and quality control:** Quality control was to be ensured through regular and frequent field visits and by testing samples of the construction work for which funds would be sanctioned by the Ministry on receipt of request from the State concerned. All the States/UTs were advised to carry out field visits, quality control tests and review all works under MsDP to ensure that the shortcomings do not take place in their State/UT.

9. **Inclusion of Members of Parliament in State and District Level Committees:** Members of Parliament (MP) and Member of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) have been included in the State and District Level Committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the Committee for MsDP. MLAs are also to be nominated on the Committees by the State Government. It should be ensured that they are invited to attend the meetings of the district and State level committees.

10 . **Foundation laying/inauguration ceremony & Display boards:** The States were requested to inform the Ministry about the completion of works and also the readiness for foundation stone laying well in advance so as to enable the Ministry to participate at appropriate level in the foundation stone laying and inauguration ceremonies in respect of projects sanctioned under this scheme. As provided in para 16.1(ii) of the scheme of MsDP it should be ensured that a 'display board' with name of the project printed followed by "Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP), Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India." For projects with longer construction period, in addition to above, the name of implementing agency, date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion and estimated cost of the project should be printed on the display boards. States/UT should ensure this during the time of construction and a permanent display put up on completion of each project.

11. General conditions applicable to projects approved by the Empowered Committee for approvals given by the Empowered Committee, including in-principle approvals, the Principal Secretary/Secretary of State's/UTs and the

District Collectors/representatives were advised to note that the following conditions would apply to all projects under MsDP. State Government/UT administration concerned should ensure that the following have been complied with:-

Approval of the State department concerned/Mission Director for Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) concerned have covered the following -

- (a) **Need** for having the proposal sanctioned under MsDP.
- (b) Duplication has been eliminated.
- (c) Proposal is as per norms, specifications, layout design, funding norms and cost norms of the CSS guidelines concerned.
- (d) **Separate accounts for schemes under MsDP will be maintained** and details sent to the Central Ministry concerned for maintaining proper record of assets and avoiding double counting and duplication.
- (e) Estimates have been prepared as per Schedule of Rates (SOR) of the State Government and have been approved by a competent engineering department of the State Govt.
- (f) **Staff is available** for functioning unit or will be provided for new unit.
- (g) **Recurring expenditure** would be provided by the State Government.
- (h) Land is available and/or will be made available by the State Government in villages/locations having the highest proportion (percentage) of minority population.

1 2 . **Review meetings of Oversight committee in State and district level committees:** The scheme of MsDP envisages quarterly review meetings by the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the review committees for MsDP. The State level committee also acts as the Oversight Committee for MsDP. Quarterly review meetings for State level committee/State Oversight Committee and district level Committee should be held and copy of the meeting notice should be sent to the Ministry to enable a representative to attend State Level meetings as envisaged under MsDP. It should be ensured that Members of Parliament nominated in such Committees are invited to attend the meetings.

14. **Provision of toilets and bathrooms:** The EC emphasized that there should be adequate number of toilets and bathrooms and provision of water in the proposed projects.

15. The Chairman (EC) emphasized that the benefits accrued by the implementation of MsDP should go to the Minority Communities properly. Therefore, not only location of the assets in the areas having substantial minority

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population is important, but it is also equally important to see that the assets created are actually imparting benefits to the minorities. The State Governments were impressed upon to propose the locations of projects under MsDP accordingly.

A. KARNATAKA

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee reviewed the status of projects sanctioned under MsDP in identified areas of Karnataka state during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects along with it's commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. It was pointed out that there is no input available on several projects approved by the Govt. in the 11th and 12th Plan. The State Govt. should provide status report of each and every project approved by the Govt. and in case if there is any delay in implementation of a project, the state Govt. should furnish justification along with the reasons for the delay to the Govt. Chairman also directed the State representative to expedite the utilization of funds released by the Ministry during 11th & 12th Plan and submit the Status reports.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The State of Karnataka has submitted a project for Digital Classroom Initiative with Integrated Teaching Device project for Government Schools under MsDP Scheme by EDCIL India Limited alongwith declaration of the State in Appendix-II of the guidelines. The component of the project would include following:-

1. Integrated Community Computer Solution - ICC
2. Multimedia Content as per State Board Syllabus of Karnataka
3. Multimedia Content as per state Board Syllabus in Urdu
4. Multimedia content as per CBSE Board
5. Science Videos and Virtual Experiments including Digital Library
6. Built-in Screen Interactivity
7. MS Windows OS Professional Version
8. Strolley Bag
9. All in one Remote
10. White Board (MATT Finish)
11. One KVA UPS with 15-20 minutes backup

2. The State has submitted the following justification for proposing the nos. of unit in above educational institution.

1. Moraji Desai Residential Schools / Colleges/ Navodhya Model Schools :

a. **Moraji Desai Residential Schools :** These schools are run by Directorate of



Minorities department of the Government of Karnataka. The schools are set up to provide free residential education from Standards VI to X to the students from minority communities and the medium of instruction is English. The total intake strength of each school is 250 students per year. There are 14 such schools under MsDP districts of Karnataka. The State has proposed to provide 3 unit in each schools.

- b. **PU Colleges** : There are around 21 PU arts and science colleges across Karnataka with a intake of 240 students every year. There are 6 PU colleges falls under MsDP district. The State has proposed to implement 1 Unit in each of these colleges.
- c. **Navodhya School** : There are around 8 Novadhya Schools across the state with an annual intake of 560 students. We are proposing 7 Novodhya Schools which falls under MsDP districts. State has proposed to provide the 4unit of Digital Classroom Initiative with Integrated Teaching Device project as per the following :
2. **Minority Post Metric Boys/ Girls Hostels** : There are 304 Minority post metric hostels for boys and girls in the state with a sanctioned strength of 75 to 100 students. There are 42 such hostels fall under MsDP districts. The State has proposed for 1 Units each to all 42 such hostels to achieve the object as pointed out in the proposal.
3. **Maulana Azad Model Schools** : The Government started 100 Maulana Azad model schools across the State in 2017 -2018. There are 14 such schools in MsDP districts and we have proposed those schools under this project. The main aim of the Government to start these schools is to bring back dropped out students and provide quality education to the children from minority communities. These schools have grades from class 6 to 10 and the medium of instruction is English. There are around 60 seats available in each school and out of which 75% is reserved for minorities. The State has proposed for two units in each school.
4. **Government Urdu Lower Primary/Higher Primary Schools** : There are around 467 Lower Primary and Higher Primary Schools under MsDP districts in the state of Karnataka. The State has proposed to provide one unit schools having less than 100 students and 2 units in schools having more than 100 students.
5. **Government Urdu Secondary/ High Schools** : There are around 53 High and Higher Secondary Urdu schools under MsDP districts of Karnataka. The State has proposed for three Units in each schools depending upon the grades.
6. **Madarsa's registered under state Government Wakf Board** : The new scheme of modernization of Madarsas will provide formal education and computer knowledge along with the religious teachings, equipping the youth with both the religious and worldly knowledge. These are registered Madarsa under the state Government Wakf Board As part of the same initiative, the state has proposed to provide Digital Classroom Initiative with Integrated Teaching Device project to all 103 Madarsas spread across in MsDP districts of



Karnataka. The state has proposed to one unit in each of these Madarsa's

4. The State provided the UDIES code of the all schools. The UDIES code was shared with the MIS of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy to get their inputs. Based on the data received from MIS of RMSA and SSA, Ministry of HRD and information furnished by State, the following was submitted before the Empowered Committee for its consideration:-

5. The Chairman while considering the project enquired about the percentage of Minority students in the schools proposed to be covered under the proposal. The representative of Govt. of Karnataka informed the EC that the Schools proposed to be covered are having around 75% students from the Minority Communities and these schools are located in the identified MCBs of MsDP.

6. The Empowered Committee approved the project and also decided to release the 1st instalment of Central Share in the following manner:-

B. MAHARASHTRA

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee(EC) reviewed the status of projects sanctioned for identified area of the Maharashtra during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects along with its commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. It was observed by Chairman, Empowered Committee that construction process for a number of Aganwadi Centres and IAY approved during 11th Plan and many projects like AWC, Health projects, Hostels approved during 12th Plan have not been started by the State. EC directed the State to start the construction of these left out projects by 31.03.2018. The Pr. Secretary, Govt. of Maharashtra assured the EC that they will made a detail review of the projects and will initiate the construction for all projects by 31.05.2018 The EC further directed the State representative to expedite the utilization of funds released by Ministry during 11th & 12th Plan and submit the Status report.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The EC considered the project for construction of a 100 seated boys hostel submitted by State. The Chairman enquired about Hostel for girls in Distt. Buldana. He directed DC, Buldana to assess the requirement of Hostel for girls and if necessary, another proposal exclusively for Girls Hostel may be submitted for consideration of the EC. The details of the project considered by the EC are as under:-

- (i). **Construction of 100 bedded Boys Hostel for Minorities:** The project for construction of 100 bedded boy's hostel for minorities was considered by EC in

its 131st meeting. The EC found the cost of project on higher side and directed the State Govt. to resubmit the project after examining the cost of project. Now the State Govt. has resubmitted the project after reducing its cost from Rs. 571.78 lakh to Rs. 496.00 lakhs. The proposal for Construction of Boys' Hostel for Minorities at Buldana District of Maharashtra was considered by the EC in its 139th meeting held on 30th January 2018. The proposal could not be discussed as the State representative was not present though the District representative was present during the VC. This has been reflected in the minutes as well.

During the meeting, it was informed by DC, Buldana that initially the project was proposed in the premise of ITI but later, the location was changed due to non-availability of the land in ITI premise for the said project. He further informed that the project would cater the need of 9 institutions situated in nearby area. The EC agreed to the project and decided to release the 1st installment of Central Share in following manner:-

C. JHARKHAND

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee reviewed the status of projects sanctioned for identified area of the Jharkhand during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects alongwith its commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. The Chairman directed the State representative to expedite the utilization of funds released by Ministry during 11th & 12th Plan and submit the Status report.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The State Govt. of Jharkhand has submitted project proposals in respect of MCBs/MCTs of all districts for implementation of MsDP along with following declaration in appendix-II of the guidelines of MsDP projects:-

- I. The cost estimates proposed for the different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work.
- II. It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are

- proposed have at least 25 % enrolment of the minority students.
- III. It has been ensured that there is no duplication of the work with any scheme of the Central Government or a State Government and the concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
 - IV. The land for all construction activities is available.
 - V. The maintenance and the recurring cost related to the assets proposed in this plan will be borne by the State Govt.
 - VI. The Plan proposal has been recommended by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.

Project details:

- i. **Construction of Primary Health Centers and Community Health Centers:** The State Government has submitted the proposal for construction of Primary Health Centers and of Community Health Centers for minorities at the rate of Rs. 236.127 lakhs and Rs. 1058.05 lakhs per unit respectively. State Govt. also submitted the letter of assurance that no funds have been sanctioned or released for these buildings either from the State Govt. or from the Govt. of India. The projects were considered by Empowered Committee in consultation with representative of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. It was informed by the State representative that there are around 188 PHCs approved under NHM. He further informed that out of these 188 unit, 22 unit is being implemented by NHM, 141 unit by State Government and 25 unit are being proposed from other sources including MsDP. The EC found the requirement of the State in accordance with the MsDP but directed the State Government to recast their proposal as per norms of IPHS and resubmit the proposals with all requisite informations.
- ii. **Construction of ACRs :** The State Government has submitted the proposal for construction of ACRs at SBSSPSJ College Pathargama at the rate of Rs. 362.08 lakh. It was informed by the State that the catchment area of the asset has around 11% population from Minority Communities. He further informed that there are around 4064 students in this educational institution out of which 321 belong to Minority communities. The EC found that this project does not fulfill the pre-requisite i.e. population of catchment area must have 25% population from Minority Community and incase of ACRs, Hostel, the enrollment of Minority Students should be more than 25%. The EC did not agree to this project and opined that the State should propose such asset only in accordance with set guidelines of the scheme. The Chairman also added that instead of proposing a project costing Rs.362 lakhs for a school as a block of ACRs, the State should come up as a separate unit of School building having all necessary facilities including toilets, drinking water etc.

D. MADHYA PRADESH

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee(EC) reviewed the status of projects sanctioned for identified area of the Madhya Pradesh during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects along with its commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. It was observed by the Chairman, Empowered Committee

that construction process of a number of Aganwadi Centres and IAY approved during 11th Plan and many projects like AWC, Health projects, School building Hostels approved during 12th Plan have not been started by the State. The representative of State assured the EC that they will make a detail review of the projects and will complete the construction of all projects by 31.05.2018. The EC further directed the State representative to expedite the utilization of funds released by Ministry during 11th & 12th Plan and submit the Status report.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The State Govt. of Madhya Pradesh has submitted project proposals in respect of MCBs/MCTs of Districts for implementation of MsDP along with following declaration in Appendix-II:-

- I. The cost estimates proposed for the different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work.
- II. It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have at least 25 % enrolment of the minority students.
- III. It has been ensured that there is no duplication of the work with any scheme of the Central Government or a State Government and the concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- IV. The land for all construction activities is available.
- V. The maintenance and the recurring cost related to the assets proposed in this plan will be borne by the State Govt.
- VI. The Plan proposal has been recommended by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.

Project details:

- i. **Construction of Sadbhav Mandap:** The State Government has submitted the proposal for construction of Sadbhav Mandap at the rate of Rs. 299.80 lakhs in 4 MCTs. As per the cost abstract submitted by the State, the total built up area of the asset is 805 SqM. This asset will contain separate toilet units for male & female and will also have suitable arrangement for parking, drinking water, sports activities and accessible to persons with disability and follow harmonized guidelines and space standards of Barrier-Free Built Environment for person with disability and elderly persons published by CPWD. On the request of the State representative for sanctioning of tax component of the project, the EC in consultation with Sr. Advisor, NAWADCO opined that the tax component of the project should be borne by the State. The EC approved the project with release of 1st installment of Central Share in following manner:

E. WEST BENGAL

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee(EC) reviewed the status of projects sanctioned for identified area of the West Bengal during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects along with its commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. It was observed by Chairman, Empowered Committee that construction process for a number of Aganwadi Centres, Health Projects and School Building approved during 11th Plan and 12th Plan have not been started/completed by the State. The representative of State informed the EC that submission of UC for only Rs.53 lakhs in respect of 11th Plan and Rs. 272 crores in respect of 12th Plan is pending with the State. He further informed that they will complete the remaining project of 11th plan by 31.03.2018 and of 12th Plan by 31.05.2018. Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal also informed the EC that they will submit Utilisation Certificate for Rs.173 crore by the 26.02.2018. The EC directed the State representative to expedite the utilization of funds released by Ministry during 11th&12th Plan.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The EC considered the projects sanctioned(in-principal) by 132nd EC in respect of West Bengal. The EC in its 132nd meeting considered the Water supply projects of West Bengal and agreed to them subject to submission of approval of SLSSC by the State. The State vide their letter no. 427-MD dated 21.02.2018 conveyed the approval of the SLSSC approved by 132nd EC. Considering this, the Empowered Committee approved the project and decided to release the 1st

installment of Central share in following manner:-

F. HARYANA

The State resubmitted their proposal for construction of Sadbhav Mandap and one Ayurveda Dispensary in Palwal District along with Appendix-II of the guidelines, however, the same could not be considered by the Empowered Committee as the Secretary of the State was not present during the meeting.

G. MIZORAM

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee(EC) reviewed the status of projects sanctioned for identified area of the Mizoram during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects along with its commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. It was observed by Chairman, Empowered Committee that construction process for a number of ACRs, Hostels, IAYs, AWC, Health Projects, School building approved during the 11th Plan and during 12th Plan have not been started/completed by the State.

The EC observed that physical progress of implementation of projects in Mizoram is very slow, as per report available with the Ministry. The Deputy Director, Minority Welfare Department, along with the Deputy Commissioners of Lawngtlai District and Mamit District stated that there could be miscommunication between the State and the Centre in respect of progress of implementation of MsDP projects. The State representatives have been directed to submit a comprehensive report on the status to the Centre at the earliest for review in its next meeting.

2. **CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-** The Empowered Committee considered the proposals of Mizoram and observed that no cost estimate/abstract are available for any of the projects. The EC directed the State representatives to furnish the details of minority population in the District/Block vis-a-vis the total population of the District/Block in which the project is proposed. It was also directed that enrolment of students and minority students in respect of projects related to schools, justification for construction of staff quarters/nurse quarters etc should also be furnished. The Empowered Committee decided to consider the proposal of the State after receipt of all required details in its subsequent meeting to be held on 5th March, 2018.

H. ARUNACHAL PRADESH

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee reviewed the status of projects sanctioned for identified area of the ~~Karnataka~~ ^{Uttar Pradesh} during 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects alongwith it's commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. It was observed that there are slight differences in the report available with the Centre and the State and the same has to be reconciled. The Chairman directed the State representative to expedite utilization of funds released by the Ministry during 11th & 12th Plan and submit the Status reports.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The Empowered Committee considered the proposals of the State and observed that the details of population and minority population is required for all projects and need to be projected in the agenda. The State representatives have been directed to submit the required details as per format required by the Ministry and furnish it at the earliest, for consideration in the next EC meeting to be held on 5th March, 2018.

I. UTTAR PRADESH

1. REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF PROJECTS APPROVED:-

The Chairman, Empowered Committee reviewed the status of projects sanctioned under MsDP in the state of Uttar Pradesh during the 11th & 12th Five Year Plan. The status of utilization of funds released by the Ministry and physical status of the projects along with it's commissioning were discussed with the representative of the State Government. Pr. Secretary, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh who was present during the meeting informed the EC that earliest completion of previously approved projects is now their priority. She also informed the EC that they are considering dropping of the projects approved during 11th & 12th Plan, which are found non viable. She added that the State will not seek further installment for projects like hand-pumps and LAYs. The EC requested the State to expedite the completion of project and utilization of funds. The EC further opined that alternate projects for dropped/project proposed to be dropped may be submitted by the State along with a formal proposal for dropping of non viable projects.

2. CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF FRESH PROJECTS FOR MCBs/MCTs:-

The Empowered Committee considered the proposals of the State and observed that the details of population and minority population is required for all projects and need to be projected in the agenda. The State representatives have been directed to submit the required details as per the format. The State of Uttar Pradesh has submitted projects for Minority Concentration Blocks under MsDP alongwith Appendix II of the guidelines:-

- The land for all construction activities is available.
- It has been ensured that all locations proposed have at least 25% minority population in its catchment area.

- It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have at least 25% enrolment of the minority students.
- The Cost estimates proposed for different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/ design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work
- No duplication of the work with any Scheme of the Centre/State Government and concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- Maintenance and recurring cost related will be borne by the concerned department of State Govt.
- The plan proposal has been approved by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.

Project details:-

(i). Govt. Polytechnic:- The State has proposed for construction of a Govt. Polytechnic at Thanabhawan of Shamli district at the unit cost of Rs.1230 lakh. The details submitted by the State was shared with the representative of Ministry of Skill & Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. He opined that the estimate and norms for the Polytechnic should be as per the approved guidelines. Jt. Director, Ministry of Skill who was representing the Ministry of Skill, asked the Empowered Committee to provide him adequate time to study the proposal for construction of Polytechnic and to submit the views of Ministry of Skill. The EC agreed to the request and deferred consideration of proposal till the submission of input by Ministry of Skill.

(ii) Construction of ITIs:- The State has proposed for construction of two units of ITIs in MCBs of Gonda district of Uttar Pradesh at the unit cost of Rs.1200 lakh. The details submitted by the State was shared with the representative of Ministry of Skill & Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. He opined that the estimate and norms for the polytechnic should be as per the approved norms of NCVT. He informed the State representative and EC that the latest guidelines for ITI is available on url ncvt.mis.gov.in. He further opined that he should be provided with adequate time to study the proposal for construction of ITI and to submit the view of Ministry of Skill. The EC agreed to the request and deferred the consideration of proposal till the submission of input by Ministry of Skill. On inquiry regarding approval of a ITI in a district, he informed the EC that at present there is no such instruction which limits the approval of not more than one ITI for a district.

(iii) Construction of Hostel:- The State has proposed for construction of 60 Bedded Hostels in 01 Govt. Polytechnic at Adampur Belsar & Utraula Road Gonda at the total cost of Rs.300 lakh. This was discussed with the Pr. Secretary, Govt. of UP. She informed the EC that the location proposed under the agenda send by State were wrong due to clerical mistake. She added that actually the State requires only one Hostel at the unit cost of Rs.150 lakh for Halder Mau block of Gonda. The EC agreed to the project.

(iv) Construction of School Building:- The State has proposed for construction of 8 school building at the unit cost of Rs.14.54 lakh each for MCBs of Sharawasti district of UP. The details submitted by the State was examined in consultation with Sr. Advisor, NAWDCO and EC approved the project at the unit cost of Rs.14.54 lakh.

(v) Construction of Ayurveda Dispensaries:- The State has proposed for

construction of 6 unit Ayurveda Dispensaries in the MCBs of Bulandshar and Bijnor at the unit cost of Rs.20.97 lakh, Rs.29.68 lakh and Rs.17.75 lakh. The Chairperson, EC discussed this project with the representative of Ministry of AYUSH. It was informed by representative of M/o AYUSH that the Govt. has 3 years back launched a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for construction of Ayurveda dispensaries. The Chairperson observed that the objective of MsDP is to fill the gap of the existing scheme of the Govt. Since the Scheme launched by M/o AYUSH is only 3 year old, it is too early to identify the existing gaps. As such, the taking of such scheme under MsDP would not be justified. The EC decided not to consider this project at present.

(vi). **Furniture for the Schools sanctioned under MsDP:-** State has requested for providing of furniture for 07nos. of Schools sanctioned in past under MsDP. The unit cost proposed for the furniture is Rs.27.3 lakh each. The EC approved the project subject to the condition that the procurement would be done as per established mechanism/JEMS.

The Empowered Committee decided to release the 1st installment of Central Share for the approved projects in following manner:-

J. Change of location(Uttar Pradesh)

The Empowered Committee in its previous meetings approved District/Blocks/Towns Plans for the Uttar Pradesh under MsDP. The funds for the projects were released to the State on the approval of the Empowered

Committee.

2. The following issues has come into the notice of the Ministry in the Block/Town plans approved by Empowered Committee.

(i). It has been conveyed by the State that the project for construction of Government Girls Inter College sanctioned by 130th EC for Village Sahpur Dagar of Pawasa block of Shambhal was originally proposed for Asmauli Block of Shambhal district. The State has now requested for change of location for the Girls Inter College sanctioned by 130th EC for Village Sahpur Dagar of Pawasa block of Shambhal to Asmauli Block of Shambhal district. The EC agreed to the proposal and allowed the state for utilization of the funds amounting released to State as 1st installment of Central Share for projects approved by 130th EC for construction of GGIC at Asmauli block of Shambhal district instead of Pawasa block.

(iii). It has been conveyed by the State that the project for construction of Government Inter College sanctioned by 130th EC for Belha ghat Town of Pratapgarh district was originally proposed as project for construction of Govt. Girls Inter College. The State has now requested for change of project from Govt. Inter College to Govt. Girls Inter College. The EC agreed to the proposal and allowed the state for utilization of the funds amounting released to State as 1st installment of Central Share for projects approved by 130th EC for above project.

(iv). It has been conveyed by the State that the project for construction of Junior High School at Kesharganj block of Bhraich was sanctioned by 129th EC. The projects was originally proposed as project for construction of Boundary Wall for Junior schools at Kesharganj block. The State has now requested for change of projects from construction of school building to construction of boundary wall.

Since, construction of Boundary wall is not in priority list of the MsDP, the EC asked the State to submit an suitable alternate projects.

(v) It has been conveyed that a project for upgradation of 6 units of upper primary schools to High School was sanctioned by 73rd EC for the Ganjdhwara Block of Kashganj district. The unit cost for the project approved by EC was Rs.58.12 lakh. It has been

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informed that the construction of work at Sujwalpur and Samaspur could not be done by the State due to land related issued. The State has now requested for change of location from Sujwalpur to Gawara and Samspur to Panchpokhra. The EC considered the request and approved it by allowing the State to utilized the funds released by Ministry as 1st installment for the projects sanctioned for Sujwalpur and Samaspur to projects proposed at Gawara and Samspur.

3. The EC noted that the State has obtained the approval of SLC for the above change of location. However it reiterated that such approval is subject to fulfillment of all prerequisites viz. Minority population more than 25% in catchment area, approval of SLC for the proposed changes etc, by the State before starting the construction at new location.

Finally, the EC decided that all State Govts. should furnish implementation report in respect of projects approved in the 11 Plan by 31st March 2018 and for the approved in the 12th Plan by 31st May 2018. In case the State Govt. are unable to start a certain project, they should immediately seek dropping of the proposals and send fresh proposals for utilisation of the funds in other approved projects or new projects.
